



MEMBERS FIRST ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

MEMBERS FIRST ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

There are four steps in the Members First Engagement Process: Greet, Discover, Solve, Close. Our success at Sears hinges on developing long-term relationships with members. The MFE process will guide you in developing those relationships. This article includes all of the details you need, including tips on how to satisfy member concerns.





During the Greet stage, initiate and execute an effective and consistent personal greeting that sparks a "WOW" member experience and drives profitable sales and member loyalty.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "Hi. Welcome to Sears. What brings you in today?"
- Reinforce/introduce the member to Shop Your Way: "Are you a Shop Your Way member?" Then articulate benefits of the program.
- Use a creative greeting to engage the member and build a relationship.
- Name exchange: "My name is Tim. And you are?"
- Reinforce why Sears is the right choice. Use Sears and/or brand advantages.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Enter phone number into SHOPsears.
- Assess member profile generated.
- Discuss the member's profile information. Say something like, "I see you are a VIP member. Thanks for your loyalty!"
- If it's a new member, explain membership benefits and show functionality on their personal device.
- Bridge to begin Discovering the specific member need.





Ask product and lifestyle questions to facilitate the discovery of each member's need in a focused manner. Help members believe that Sears is the expert in their area of need.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "How are you going to use this product?"
- "I would like to ask you some questions to narrow down the products that would fit your need."
- "Tell me about the product research you have done."

- "What do you like/dislike about your current product?"
- "How big is your room?"
- "Will you need delivery?"
- "How do you intend to service your purchase?"

WHAT YOU DO:

- Ask open-ended questions to understand the member's present and future needs.
 Determine wants versus needs.
- Select subcategory in SHOPsears product selector.
- Select answers to specific SHOPsears questions to pinpoint the member's need.
- Add items viewed by members to the Shopping Recap.
- Select up to three products to create comparison.



It's important to educate members and customize a complete solution with accessories and services to meet their immediate and future needs, showing them that Sears has the expertise and the products they need.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "Based on the information you have provided, I would recommend the following products."
- "I will explain the features and benefits of the units that meet your need."
- "I do not have one of the products on the floor, so I will show a video demonstration."
- "I will walk you through the details and benefits of our credit options to enhance your experience."

WHAT YOU DO:

- Educate the member on features and benefits of the product selections.
- Demonstrate the features either on the sales floor or through video clips get the members involved.
- Select accessories that go with the product and explain how they're used.
- Recommend the product solution (with accessories) that will meet/exceed their needs.
- Educate about credit options.
- Identify bundling options/Buyer's Picks that provide additional value.



Now it's time to "Ask for the Sale" as a natural conclusion based on the relationship and credibility created during the interaction. Synergize a personal and digital experience that completes the transaction, preferably in the moment, but otherwise in the future.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "Based on the information you have provided, this product meets your needs. What day next week works well for you to take delivery of the product?"
- If the member agrees to purchase, then process the transaction.
- If the member isn't ready to buy, say, "I have tracked all of the items we've discussed in your profile. Allow me to send you a Shopping Recap. You can purchase the products online or come back in the store. You can also reach me through the member assist app. I will call you back directly to answer questions you may have."

WHAT YOU DO:

- Close the sale.
- Execute transaction based on base product, accessories, PA and credit.
- Assign Delivery and MPU to complete the member experience.
- If the member didn't buy right away:
 - Get permission to send a Shopping Recap.
 - Get permission to follow up with a phone call in two days to assist with Shopping Recap and next steps.
 - Demonstrate digital tools (i.e., Member Assist)



It's important that you view concerns as opportunities for members to learn more about the products they're interested in.

WHAT YOU SAY:

Member: I am not sure if this will work for me. I have no idea how to put it together.

You: Oh, sounds like you are concerned about assembling the product at home.

Member: Yes.

You: Is that your only concern?

Member: No, I am also concerned about learning how to use

it to get the results I want.

You: I understand that assembling and using new products can be intimidating. We are at your service! Sears has delivery service that will set up the product and show you how to use it. After you start using the product, you can call me directly if you have questions. Are you able to take delivery on Tuesday?

WHAT YOU DO:

 Step 1 — Clarify by asking question(s) to make sure you understand the concern.

 Step 2 — Agree to a degree. Start your response with a positive, such as "I understand assembling and using new products can be intimidating."

 Step 3 — Give more information relevant to the concern.

• Step 4 — Ask for the sale.

 Successful associates view concerns as opportunities to help the member make an informed decision and lead them to closing the sale.

 Concerns can occur at any time during the interaction. Be prepared to handle them "on demand."



OVERCOMING OBJECTIONS

OVERCOMING OBJECTIONS

Remember, an objection is simply a request for more information.

Always be alert for signals that our members are sending you and where you can provide solutions. Signals can be verbal or nonverbal. When you notice one, you can ask questions or make statements that acknowledge our members' thoughts, concerns or hesitations about making the purchase.

It's natural for members who are interested in buying to want to know more about the product, so they ask questions. They're not yet confident that they're making the right decision until their objections are overcome. They often raise these questions in the form of objections to buying the item.



This is your opportunity to help them learn more about the product and the total value this potential purchase represents. Take the time to listen to their objections, and guide them with your product knowledge so they can make the decision to buy from Sears. Be alert to buying signals.

You will want to:

- Clarify their objections.
- Build confidence in their choice.
- Reiterate the benefits of the product they have chosen.
- Demonstrate that the product meets their specific needs.
- Show them that they are getting value for what they're buying.
- Remove the barriers that are preventing them from buying today!
- Seek agreement with them about the advantages of buying the total solution.

Once our members appear to have found the total solution that meets all their needs, it's time to reinforce their feelings about the products selected. Present two or three of the product's features and benefits that will meet the needs they expressed or solve the problem caused by their current product.

- Our online resources
- Delivery
- Assembly
- Repair services overcoming objections

- Financing options
- And more!

WHY DO MEMBERS WALK?

We'll work through some of these reasons so you can be prepared for any selling situation.

ASSOCIATES ARE NOT ASSERTIVE OR CONFIDENT

They don't take control of the sale.

They don't tie member wants/needs to product benefits.

They allow the sale to drift, are unfocused and don't take control of the close.

They don't relate to our members (i.e., ask a member, "Who in your household will be using the treadmill?").

SALES TIP

There are four common objections you can overcome:

- Price
- Product
- Personal
- Postponement of purchase

Don't interrupt at the first objection you hear. Listen and acknowledge what each member is saying.

ASSOCIATES DON'T HANDLE OBJECTIONS FROM MEMBERS

Objections may be member perceptions, misunderstandings, lack of information or real obstacles. You can resolve many of these by simply listening to our members and following the selling process to help find their solutions.

How do you recognize objections?

Why is addressing each one important?

How do you keep a positive attitude when addressing behaviors/barriers?

COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS OUR MEMBERS MAY HAVE:

"Everyone carries treadmills."

"Sears is always priced higher than other retailers." Discuss the Price Match Plus Policy.

"Extended Warranties and MPAs are the same thing." Explain that MPAs offer services above and beyond those provided by a product's warranty. Warranties usually only cover defects in materials and workmanship.

SALES TIP

- Use the online tools to overcome any misconceptions our members may have.
- When members object, it indicates that they're emotionally involved with your product. These are usually buying signals that you can use to your benefit.

OVERCOMING OBJECTIONS

ATTITUDE

You are the most important part of any sale. It's your professional responsibility to offer our members a shopping experience that they'll remember.

HOW DOES NOT BEING ASSERTIVE/CONFIDENT AFFECT SALES?

When you're confident, our members feel that you can take care of their needs and help them find the right product.

Example: You want to feel like your mechanic knows what is wrong with your car and how to fix it, right?

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ASSERTIVE AND PUSHY?

Pushy is when members feel like they're being "sold" rather than making an informed buying decision. Be confident and assertive without being pushy.

ARE YOU LISTENING TO OUR MEMBERS' "BUYING SIGNALS"?

TRIAL CLOSE - ASKING THE QUESTIONS

To assure that you close the sale, there's a simple technique you can use. It's known as the "trial close." The trial close asks for an opinion, which allows you to further understand our members. A closing question asks for the SALE or a decision from our members. The closing question is done near the end of the sales process.

- "What model best suits your needs?"
- "Will you be taking advantage of our No Interest/No Payments offer?"
- "What number is better for Delivery to call you and confirm the time?"

SALES TIP

Always remember to smile. It'll put our members at ease.

CLOSING THE SALE: WHAT TO SAY

ATTEMPT TO CLOSE THE SALE WITH EVERY MEMBER.

KEYS TO A SUCCESSFUL CLOSE:

- Leverage the information that you learned in the Discovery Phase related to More Ways to Pay. Is our member interested in:
 - Additional savings today?
 - Short-term financing with no-interest expense?
 - A longer financing plan with fixed payments and lower interest?
 - Layaway?
- Ask members if they would like to take the product home with them today or have it delivered on another day.
- Be sure to include the accessory items that you presented to our members

3 WAYS TO BUY

It's important that our members leave your store with the Fitness products they desire. If it looks like price is going to be a deal breaker for them, be sure to present them with all of our payment options. They can apply for a Sears Card, lease the item or use layaway to pay for it.

1. SEARS CARDS



WHEN TO OFFER

We always want to offer the Sears card to members as the first payment option. If members don't have a Sears Card, we would like them to apply for either a Sears MasterCard or Sears Card.

Applying for a Sears Card is easy! Let the member know that all it takes is a few minutes and a valid photo ID, then just follow the register prompts. And it allows them to take the merchandise home that day.

3 KEYS TO CLOSING SEARS CARD SALES



Key 1

Know your weekly Sears Card offers that are maintained on the Reference App. Search by using the key words "card offers" or "promo calendar."

Explain the benefits of using the Sears Card:

- Save money (e.g., 5% instant savings)
- No interest financing
- Earn more (e.g., 2% in Shop Your Way Points)

Ask for the sale by asking our member which offer would work best for them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Ask: "May I put this on your Sears Card?"

Tell Why: "SYW members who use their Sears Card can earn 2% in SYW Points for all their Sears purchases."

Ask: "Did you know you can save \$15 if you are approved for a Sears MasterCard today? All it takes is a valid photo ID and a few minutes of your time."

2. LEASING

WHEN TO OFFER

Offer Leasing if a member is declined for a Sears Card, or is not interested in applying for a Sears card and wants a solution where NO credit is required.

MEMBER BENEFITS

- 1. No credit required
- 2. Members can take merchandise home that day with a minimal payment
- 3. Gives them the option to:
 - Own the merchandise after minimum payment terms as little as five months!
 - Extend the payment terms
 - Return merchandise to WhyNotLeaselt

3. LAYAWAY

WHEN TO OFFER

Offer Layaway if the member does not need the merchandise today, or if the member applied for a Sears Card and was declined.

MEMBER BENEFITS

- 1. Lock in today's low prices
- 2. Pay NO interest
- Pay over time: Usually 8 weeks, but 12 weeks available on purchases of \$400 or more (26 weeks in Fine Jewelry)



HOW TO SAY IT

Say: While we were unable to approve your request for a Sears Card, you have been preapproved for a Lease through WhyNotLeaselt. The program is easy and affordable."

Ask: "Can I tell you how it works?"

Why: "The Leasing program allows you to take your merchandise home today. All we need is an initial payment."

HOW TO SAY IT

Say: "Our Layaway program allows you to reserve your items at today's prices and take them home once the Layaway is paid in full."

Ask: "Would you like to put this on Layaway today?"

Tell Why: "For \$5 and a small down payment you can lock in today's low prices. We'll hold your items while you pay off your Layaway over time at NO interest!"

SHOP YOUR WAY PROGRAM



PROGRAM OVERVIEW


Shop Your WaySM (SYW) was created to allow our members to earn points and to engage in the program and receive special offers and event invitations. Once enrolled, members simply provide their phone number or e-mail address at the time of purchase to earn SYW points for qualifying purchases.

Members have the choice to spend earned rewards on their next purchase, or they can accumulate rewards and save them for a future purchase. Participation in the Shop Your Way program is free. Members will see their "earned" status on their sales receipt. Members may go online to create a profile, view special offers, view purchase history, add transactions, customize their PIN (required to redeem over \$10 PINless redemption) and much more!

ENROLLMENT IS EASY

Any member 13 years old or older is eligible for enrollment. For enrollment, our members will need to provide first name, last name, ZIP code and valid e-mail address (we encourage a phone number for easy account lookup), as well as to accept SYW Terms & Conditions.

Once enrolled, members will receive a personal identification number (PIN) via e-mail. Remember, the PIN is required to redeem points. Point of Sale will allow members to redeem their rewards points without a PIN*—if the redemption value is \$10 or less!

VIP PROGRAM

COMPLETING MEMBER PROFILES

It's important for you to encourage VIPs (new and old) to complete their Member Profile. Since we no longer mandate the collection of birthdays and home addresses from our VIPs, we need them to supply that information voluntarily so that they can get the most out of their exclusive membership.

For example, without birthdays and home addresses, we can't mail VIPs their welcome kit with their personalized VIP card and key fob, and we can't deliver their birthday bonus offer. Urge members to provide this information in their Member Profile at shopyourway.com; this will make the VIP program all the more successful!



WHAT IS THE VIP PROGRAM?

The VIP program is a way for Sears to thank their most valued Shop Your Way members by providing them with even more benefits. There are 3 VIP tiers:

- VIP Silver spend \$2,500 in a calendar year
- VIP Gold spend \$5,000 in a calendar year
- VIP Platinum spend \$10,000 in a calendar year

WHO CAN QUALIFY FOR THE VIP PROGRAM?

Any SHOP YOUR WAY member in active standing will be able to qualify for VIP tiers, including associates.

WHAT BENEFITS DO MEMBERS GET FROM BEING A VIP MEMBER?

Some examples of VIP benefits include:

- Personalized card and key fob
- Dedicated concierge service
- Earn extra points on VIP-only bonus days
- Get extra points on all birthday month purchases
- Get coupons throughout the year via e-mail for a \$4.99 conventional oil change including free tire rotation
- 20% in points on all Alphaline Electronics

- Save 20% on every order from Sears Flowers by Tele Flora
- Get 15% off in-home appliance repair service
- Get \$10 back in points (10,000 points) on a qualifying pet supply purchase of \$30 or more
- Special Friends and Family event shopping hours

The more a member spends over a year on qualifying purchases, the higher VIP tier they achieve and the better the benefits they enjoy on special Bonus Days and the Birthday Bonus offer. For example:

- VIP Silver 5% back in Points
- VIP Gold 10% back in Points
- VIP Platinum 15% back in Points

DOES MY VIP MEMBERSHIP EXPIRE?

Upon achieving tier status, members maintain that status for the remainder of the current year and all of the following year (unless they subsequently qualify for a higher tier). For example, if a member qualifies for VIP Silver in August 2013, they will maintain VIP Silver until the end of December 2014. Please remember, the member must spend at least \$2,500 in the 2014 calendar year to maintain VIP Silver through the end of 2015.



HOW WILL MY MEMBER KNOW IF THEY HAVE REACHED VIP STATUS?

Ongoing member communication, primarily through e-mail and personal web pages, provides updates to members on their status. New VIPs who have provided their home address in their member Profile will receive a VIP Welcome Kit soon after qualification. The VIP Welcome Kit delivers their personalized VIP Card and outlines program mechanics and benefits.

ATTACHMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SELLING

Most Fitness purchases require the additional sale of attachments and accessories so that our members will have all they need to get the most out of their new Fitness products. Selling attachments and accessories with every purchase is a great way to improve members' satisfaction with their purchase. It's also a great way to get more money in your pocket. As a Sears associate, be sure to ask our members discover questions and help to provide them with The Total Solution.

HOW TO SELL ACCESSORIES AND ATTACHMENTS:

- 1. Use positive statements such as, "I recommend..." or "You will need a..."
- 2. Walk our members over to the attachment or accessory and hand it to him or her. Talk about the benefits of the item and why they'll need it.

If members can't find the accessories and attachments they're looking for on the sales floor, be sure to point out that Sears offers a large assortment of accessories and attachments on Sears.com.

<u>MASTER PROTECTION AGREEMENT SELLING</u>

Be sure to ask our members questions as to how they plan on servicing their new products during the Play phase of the Play to Win process. This way, you'll be able to bring the Master Protection Agreement (MPA) features and benefits to life. An MPA provides far superior peace of mind for members and added protection of their investment versus a typical manufacturer's warranty. By presenting the value of the MPA versus the typical manufacturer's warranty using the MPA "Value at a Glance" sheets, our members will gain a better understanding of how they can save money and control their service expenses over the life of their products.

Some fitness products have a Sears PurchaseProtect (SPP) plan available. Be sure to offer our members the SPP on eligible purchases. The SPP provides members with smart and convenient replacement coverage for their purchases.

ATTACHMENTS and **ACCESSORIES**

How to Say It — and Do It!!

Simply ask our members. You'll be surprised how many members will say "Yes" if you just ask.

- "As we discussed, our five-year protection agreement will keep your equipment in peak running condition, and it will help you budget your repairs for less than \$10 a month. Shall I include the Master Protection Agreement with this sale?"
- If the member says, "Yes," then ring up the MPA with the sale.
- If the member says, "No," say the following: "Let me take a few moments and recap the value of the Master Protection Agreement so you can fully understand the value and benefits it will provide to you." (Use the MPA Value at a Glance sheet for the specific product line, and review the features/benefits with the member.) You can enjoy all this peace of mind for only less than \$10 a month. Would you like to include it in your purchase today?"

HOW TO CROSS SELL EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES


An exercise mat and PA should be offered with every equipment sale, but what else can be offered? Try to understand our members' needs and desired fitness outcome:

KEY GOAL -

- Running offer a foam roller so that they can help remove knots and cramps from their muscles after running
- Weight loss offer a slimmer belt to increase weight loss
- Building muscle offer a set of dumbbells, kettle bells or a free weight set to improve muscle mass
- Toning offer a set of exercise bands or stability ball to firm and tone muscles
- Treadmills offer an equipment mat or treadmill maintenance kit with every purchase

SHOPPING RECAP GUIDELINES

Every time you interact with our members, there are two potential outcomes: They purchase a product or they don't. We have a digital solution for each outcome.



ALWAYS INTRODUCE THE RECAP PROPERLY




Every time a member discusses a product with you but decides not to purchase that day, you should offer a Recap. Legally, you must ask for the member's consent before sending a Shopping Recap. You should say:

"I'd be happy to send you an e-mail recapping everything that we've looked at today. Additionally, we can send you offers and other information that you may find helpful. Is that OK?"

WHY SHOULD I SEND A SHOPPING RECAP?

Creating a digital relationship with our members makes it more likely they will come back and buy from you. If our member buys online, you still get paid commission!



Ordering Parts for members is even easier for associates in our retail stores. The PartsDirect business has moved the entire Parts inventory to Sears.com! This means that all of the Parts you search for now on the PartsDirect site are also available on Sears.com and will be checked out on Sears.com. What does this mean for you? The biggest advantage is Parts orders are now eligible for "Reserve and Pay." This means members are able to pay for Parts they order from Sears.com using cash, check or debit right at POS by using the existing Reserve and Pay process! We know that associates have been asking for this ability for some time and we are excited to deliver it. Here is a complete list of new features that this will allow:

- Members can choose "Reserve and Pay" and pay for Parts orders at POS while on an in-store web station.
- Members can pay for a Parts order using a Sears Gift card.
- Members can pay for a Parts order using PayPal.

Our members are regularly checking various websites so they know what stores have to offer and at what prices. It's important that you do the same. Stay on top of what our competitors are doing by visiting their websites. By knowing the competition, you'll have a better understanding of exactly where we have our greatest advantages.

DELIVERY

Sears Delivery can deliver and assemble some fitness products so members can begin using them right away. Some products require separate Installation to be purchased. See below for details.

DELIVERY

It's important for you to understand the guidelines for delivery and installation services. With the bulk and large size of fitness equipment, members may need help transporting their purchases. Sears Delivery not only moves the item from the distribution center to the member's home, but it also ensures that the item is not damaged in the process. Delivery is great for purchases such as:

- Treadmills
- Ellipticals
- Strength machines
- And more!

Delivery will deliver and assemble the following fitness items when members purchase Delivery and indicate they desire assembly versus "leave in carton":

- Treadmills
- Ellipticals
- Exercise cycles

Delivery will deliver weight training/strength machines, but Installation (Contractor Services) would need to be purchased for assembling those items.

Game Tables can be particularly difficult to deliver, given that most are located in the basement. Alert our members to the possibility that the table they want may be difficult to fit down a stairway. This is where you introduce the "Walk the Path" ruler.



WALK PATH

To help create a "Wow" member experience, and at the same time drive profitable sales by reducing returns and cancellations, we are providing some new tools for the Sporting Goods Department. On the Reference App you will find a list of all the Fitness Equipment showing the dimensions of each item, both "in-carton" and "assembled." You will also find a photo of the "Walk the Path" Ruler (POWS #10450) that we have been using successfully for many years throughout the store. Using these two tools in combination will ensure that our members know what to expect when their new purchase arrives. They will be certain it will fit in the intended location and be prepared to have a clear path prepared to the items ultimate location.

Instruct associates to take the following steps as part of the selling process to provide the best solution for our members:

- 1. At the point in your presentation where you ask if the member wants delivery or "Take With," introduce the importance of having a clear path to the location where the item will be used.
- 2. Offer our members a "Walk the Path" ruler and write in the product measurements, both "in-carton" and "assembled" as indicated on the list we are providing.
- 3. Explain to our members how to use the ruler to both measure the space where the item will be used and to walk the path from the home entrance to the final location.
- 4. Be sure to explain that a large space will be needed to actually lay out the parts and assemble the equipment.

TREADMILLS

Even with the increasing popularity of ellipticals, treadmills are still the largest category in the fitness industry. Treadmills are popular for a number of reasons:

- More results: For a majority of members, treadmills are the best calorie burner among cardio equipment.
- More natural: Walking and running are activities our members are familiar with, so there's little to learn.
- More flexibility: Run, jog or walk on a flat surface or uphill. Members can adjust their level of intensity for a custom workout.

There are many things for members to consider when purchasing a treadmill or incline trainer. We'll attempt to cover the major considerations in the following pages.

MOTORS

- A treadmill is only as good as its motor; the larger and heavier the motor, the longer the treadmill will last.
- Motorized treadmills have one motor that drives the belt and another (the lift motor) that
 raises and lowers the running bed to create an incline. Motors allow members to set the
 pace for their workout so they can stay on track.

MOTOR SIZE

We have worked with our vendors to simplify the motor horsepower ratings. In this year's assortment, all treadmill motors will be rated in "continuous" horsepower, which is the most stringent rating in the industry. This allows you to fairly compare motors between all of our models.

When it comes to motor size, the important question is, "What does that mean for our member?" The stronger the motor, the more stress it will handle from the user. Stress comes in two forms: the user's weight and how fast he or she is running. If a runner is on a treadmill with a small motor, then the belt can hesitate under the runner's feet. This gives the running experience a choppy feel. A strong motor will not hesitate under the force of the runner's foot hitting the belt.

Rule of Thumb: 3 HP or higher = running; 2.75 HP to 2.25 HP = jogging; 2 HP or less = walking.

TREADMILL HORSEPOWER EXPLAINED

Any electric motor can be tested and given a rating. Treadmill horsepower ratings usually fall under one of three categories: Continuous Duty, Treadmill Duty and Peak. The difference is how the motor is tested. Any motor can be tested by one or more of the following ratings: Continuous HP, Treadmill HP and Peak.

The tests:

- **Continuous Duty** The motor is able to perform "continuously" without overheating. The highest level of horsepower that the motor is able to obtain and maintain within the functional range is the Continuous Duty rating.
- **Treadmill Duty** Treadmills are not designed to run continuously, so the motor is tested for a specified time, such as two hours, and the highest horsepower at which the motor is able to function during that duration is the Treadmill Duty rating.
- Peak Test A peak horsepower test is not an acceptable rating for treadmills; products
 that commonly use this rating are vacuums and hair dryers. However, some makers of
 treadmills use this rating because the numerical value of the peak test can be up to 4 to 5
 points higher than that of a Continuous Duty rating.

Using the Continuous Duty rating, as we do at Sears, is the most reliable and respected way to rate the power and performance of treadmill motors.



CUSHIONING

Cushioning systems are important elements of the treadmill experience. They're designed so that the running experience is more forgiving on our members' joints. As they move from walking to jogging to running on a treadmill, the cushioning systems have to absorb more impact. If the cushioning system did not absorb the additional force, then the experience would feel similar to running on a cement sidewalk.

Explaining the complex engineering aspects of each system is probably not helpful for members. Instead, keep it simple. Get them on the treadmill so they can feel the difference for themselves. If they don't feel comfortable running or they aren't wearing the right shoes, no problem — simply have them stand on

the treadmill belt, rise up on their tip-toes and drop their heels onto the treadmill. They'll be able to feel the give of the machine without having

to run in the store.

All NordicTrack treadmills in this year's assortment come with adjustable cushioning. This allows our members to buy one treadmill and get the 'Best of Both Worlds'. Turn it on for superior impact reduction and joint comfort. Turn it off for a surface that feels like the road.

SALES TIP

Some members may ask how much cushioning they should have. Some want more give in their treadmill than others - it's a personal preference. They will just need to pick the treadmill they find most comfortable.

RUNNING SURFACE

The treadmills that Sears offers range in running surface from 18"–22" wide and 50"–60" long. What does this mean to our members? More running surface is really for safety and comfort. When the user is getting tired and "misses a step" while running, having the extra length on the treadmill will give extra time to catch up with the speed of the belt rather than falling off the back of the treadmill.

Also, near the end of a workout, most users typically float around the treadmill more. In short, the extra running surface gives them more room for error. Lastly, taller users have a greater need for extra running space.



INCLINE

Generally speaking, when the incline increases by a degree, the user has to work about 10% harder. So if the member wants to work harder but not run faster, the incline feature offers that option. All of the treadmills in the fall assortment have an incline feature, ranging from 10%–15%.

In the fall 2013 assortment, Sears will carry at least two incline trainers (NordicTrack models #24927 X7i and #24928 X9i) that will incline



up to 40%, which is great for members seeking to build leg strength and burn extra calories.


DECLINE

A few select treadmills offer the option of decline, which allows members to mimic real terrain, activate more muscle groups and potentially give members a needed break during their workout. The NordicTrack models #24932 Elite 3200, #24934 Elite 5700, #24937 Elite 7700, #24927 X7i Incline and #24928 X9i all offer the decline advantage.

PROGRAMS

As fitness sales associates, many of you have heard the phrase, "I don't need all the bells and whistles." Programs for many members are meaningless unless you give them value. Programs are really for two purposes: motivation and direction.

- Motivation Programs can help our members set goals and push themselves.
- Direction Many members are relatively new to fitness and don't know where to start. It does a user no good to jump on a treadmill, sprint for four minutes, burn out and jump off. Programs can keep the user honest and moving towards their fitness goals.



HEART RATE PROGRAMMING

One key feature that many treadmills have is the ability to monitor heart rate. If our member is wearing a wireless heart rate chest strap, then his or her heart rate is instantly displayed on the console. Heart rate is an accurate way to determine how hard the user is working. Heart rate programs are typically designed to keep members in a zone where they're putting in a solid effort, but not working so hard that they'll burn out.

If our members are working too hard, then the treadmill slows down or lowers the incline. If they're not working hard enough, the treadmill speeds up or increases the incline. This type of programming makes sure they get the most out of their workout.

Also, as they get into better physical shape, they'll need to work harder to hit the same heart rate, so the program will naturally progress with them.

These NordicTrack and AFG treadmills come with both the wireless heart rate chest strap and the heart rate programs: #24927, #24937, #24934, #24932, #24990, #24978, #21094, #24928.

The Norditrack C700 item #24988 is heartrate-monitor compatible, but our members will need to purchase the chest strap separately.

DISCOVER QUESTIONS

Q. Is this your first treadmill purchase or are you replacing one?

A. If it's their first treadmill purchase, ask additional discover questions to make sure you help them find what they need. If they're replacing an existing one, ask what features and benefits they liked and disliked about their previous one.

Q. Where is your treadmill going to be used?

A. This is a space consideration to help members know if they have room to store or if they need a fold-up option. Also, if members are going to place their treadmill on a hard floor, they may want to consider buying a mat to put underneath. The mat is not necessary for the operation of the treadmill, but it will help to reduce noise.

ELLIPTICALS

Over the past few years, ellipticals have been the fastest-growing category in fitness equipment. Ellipticals mimic a jogging or running motion without the impact. This type of workout burns calories almost as effectively as treadmills, and it is typically easier on our members' joints. If a member has suffered from knee, hip or back injuries before, then an elliptical may be the right piece of fitness equipment for him or her.

FRONT DRIVE VS. REAR DRIVE

Which is better: front- or rear-drive ellipticals? Many of us have heard this question, and there is no simple answer. The truth is that there are multiple factors that contribute to the way the stride feels on an elliptical — the number of pivot points, where the pivot points are located, the length of the stride, whether the footpads pivot, whether it has incline and whether it's front, rear or center drive.



SALES TIP

The member typically doesn't care about the engineering aspects of how an elliptical is built. When members ask about front versus rear drive, what they're really saying is, "I see a lot of ellipticals. How do I know which one to buy?"

The right way to answer this question is by telling the truth. One style is not necessarily better than another. Each elliptical has a different design and a unique feel. For members to choose the right elliptical, they have to try several models to see which one feels best.

STRIDE LENGTH

The average member will feel most comfortable between 17" and 22" in stride length. Taller members will typically want longer stride lengths. However, it's important to remember that the different designs of each elliptical can make the same stride length feel very different. So again, the right answer is to get the member to try multiple ellipticals.

Often the elliptical will have two users of varying height. In these situations, members should consider ellipticals with adjustable stride lengths. This way, multiple users can adjust the stride length of the elliptical to fit their preference when exercising.

ADJUSTABLE INCLINE

This feature allows members to determine which muscle groups get the most strenuous workout. Typically, as the incline gets higher, the glutes and calves become more involved. Plus, as the incline increases, the user has to work harder, which burns more calories, similar to a treadmill.



FLYWHEEL

On many spec sheets for ellipticals, there is a line telling you how heavy the flywheel is. Flywheel size to an elliptical is like motor size to a treadmill. The heavier the flywheel, the smoother the elliptical motion will be.

PROGRAMS

Chances are, you've heard a member say, "I don't need all the bells and whistles." Programs for many members are meaningless unless you give them value. Programs are really for two purposes, motivation and direction.

Motivation — Programs can help the user set goals and push him/herself.

Direction — Many members are relatively new to fitness and don't know where to start. It does a user no good to jump on an elliptical, sprint for four minutes, burn out and jump off. Programs can keep users honest and moving toward their fitness goals.



HEART RATE PROGRAMMING

One key feature that many ellipticals have is the ability to monitor the member's heart rate. When they wear a wireless heart rate chest strap, their heart rate is instantly displayed on the console.

Heart rate is an accurate way to determine how hard users are working. Heart rate programs are typically designed to keep them in a zone where they're exerting effort, but not so much that they'll burn out. If they're working too hard, the elliptical reduces resistance or lowers the incline (where applicable). If they're not working hard enough, the elliptical increases resistance or the incline. This type of programming makes sure that they get the most out of their workout. Also, as they get into better physical shape, they'll need to work harder to hit the same heart rate, so the program will naturally progress with them.

These ellipticals come with both the wireless heart rate chest strap and the heart rate programs: NordicTrack models #23590 Elite 10.7, #23954 Elite 12.7 and AFG models #21095 3.1AE and #21096 4.1AE. 

CYCLES

Exercise cycles provide great cardiovascular workouts and help burn fat with little impact. With a large assortment to choose from, you will need to help our members find a cycle that is both comfortable and capable of helping them achieve their goals.

RECUMBENT VS. UPRIGHT VS. SPINNING CYCLES

- A recumbent exercise cycle is easier on the user's back and knees, so it's a little less strenuous of a workout, and it's a good choice for someone with back issues.
- In general, exercising on an upright exercise cycle is a slightly better workout than exercising
 on a recumbent cycle. Also, an upright cycle typically costs slightly less for the same overall
 features as a recumbent.
- The main difference between a spinning cycle and stationary exercise cycle is the spinner has a flywheel that simulates momentum. It most closely resembles riding an outdoor bicycle. This feature prevents members from simply stopping the peddling motion once started, because the pedals are locked into the flywheel. This means there's no coasting. To stop the pedals and flywheel once momentum has built up, our members simply need to press down on the emergency brake that is on or next to the resistance handle.







SALES TIP

If the above information doesn't help our members decide between different types of exercise cycles, focus on having them choose the style that is most comfortable for them.

STEP-THRU DESIGNS

If mobility is an issue for our members, a recumbent cycle with a step-thru feature is a great choice. This makes it much easier for members to get in and out of the exercise cycle.

THE SPINNING ADVANTAGE

A spinning exercise cycle is designed to feel similar to a real racing bicycle; it has a more aggressive seated position. "Climbing" on a spinning cycle is similar to riding a racing bicycle uphill. Our members can turn the resistance up high enough that they have to stand on the pedals in order to complete the rotation. If they're looking for a more vigorous workout, a spinning bike may be ideal. Remember, the seat and handle bars will adjust up and down (for height) and forward and backwards (for reach). It may take a little adjusting to get them fitted correctly.



RECUMBENT HANDLES

Sometimes our members may sit down in a recumbent exercise cycle and begin to pedal while holding onto the handles behind the console. If they make this common mistake, politely inform them that holding onto those handles while exercising will make the experience uncomfortable. The handles are simply for helping them get on and off of the recumbent.




SEATS ON UPRIGHT AND SPINNING CYCLES



The seats on a majority of upright and spinning cycles can be replaced with any normal bicycle seat. Our members only need a few wrenches to change the seat. So if a member loves the cycle but hates the seat, the solution is in your bicycle accessory section, where there are replacement seats and gel covers.

PROGRAMS

As a fitness sales associate, you've most likely heard the phrase, "I don't need all the bells and whistles." For many members, programs are meaningless unless you — the sales associate — give them value. Programs serve two purposes: motivation and direction. Programs offer motivation because they can help our members set goals and push themselves. Programs provide direction because many members are relatively new to fitness and don't know where to start. It won't do them any good to jump on an exercise cycle, sprint for four minutes, burn out and then jump off. Programs keep members moving towards their fitness goals.



HEART RATE PROGRAMMING

Many models offer programs based on heart rate. If a member wears the wireless heart rate chest strap while working out, his or her heart rate will be instantly displayed on the console. Heart rate is an accurate way to determine how hard the user is working. The programs are typically designed to keep members in a zone where they are putting in a solid effort, but not working so hard they'll burn out.

So, if the user is working too hard, then the cycle will reduce resistance. If they're not working hard enough, then the cycle increases resistance. This type of programming ensures that our members get the most out of their workout. Also, as they get into better physical shape, they'll need to work harder to hit the same heart rate, so the program will naturally progress with them.

STRENGTH TRAINING EQUIPMENT

Strength training is a broad category that includes weights, toning bands, core training and sport-specific training. If a member is looking to lose fat or gain muscle, then one of the most effective types of training for this goal is strength training. Cardio is equally important, but a combination of the two is key to a complete fitness solution. If a member has picked out a treadmill, then it is fair to ask if they are doing any strength training to complete their workout. Adding this element to their workout does not have to be expensive; a set of dumbbells or toning bands is enough to get the member started.

Strength training can:

- Help increase metabolism. Muscle burns more calories than fat, so the more muscle our members have, the more calories they'll burn all day long.
- Strengthen bones.
- Improve strength and muscular endurance.
- Help to avoid injuries.
- Improve coordination and balance.

STRENGTH TRAINING BASICS

Choosing the number of sets, repetitions and amount of weight can be the most confusing part of strength training. As a sales associate, you should always recommend that our members talk to their doctor and/or consult with a certified personal trainer. However, the points below are generally accepted guidelines for strength training:

- To lose body fat and build muscle: Members should use enough weight to complete 10–12 repetitions and one-three sets maximum (one for beginners, two-three for intermediate and advanced exercisers). Rest for 30 seconds to a minute between sets and leave at least one day between workout sessions when working on the same muscle group.
- For health and toning: Members should use enough weight to complete 12–16 repetitions, one–three sets, resting 20–30 seconds between sets and at least one day between workout sessions when working on the same muscle group.

To help our members determine how much weight they should use, have them start with a light weight and perform one set. Continue adding weight until they reach the desired number of repetitions. The last rep should be difficult, but not impossible, and our members should be able to keep good form.

KEY FITNESS PRODUCT INFORMATION YOU MUST KNOW:

TREADMILLS

Treadmills are the best calorie burner among all cardio equipment. There are several features that should be explained during the discover phase of the member engagement process:

- The stronger the motor, the more stress it will handle. Stress comes in two forms:
 The member's weight and how fast he/
 she is walking or running. A smaller motor might create an uncomfortable, choppy feeling. A stronger motor won't hesitate. As a rule of thumb, you should recommend a 3-horsepower or higher treadmill for running.
- The cushioning system in the treadmill is more important the faster the users go. Running places more strain on the joints than walking, so members need to consider this during the selection process. In addition, the faster they go, the longer their stride, the more important the size of the running surface becomes.
- When the incline increases by a degree, the user has to work approximately 10% harder. Incline forces members to work harder without running faster.
- Console programs help keep members motivated and provide direction by guiding them toward their fitness goals. Some models can provide heart rate monitoring as well.

ELLIPTICALS

THERE ARE THREE TYPES OF ELLIPTICALS:

- Front Mechanism
- Rear Mechanism
- Mid-mechanism



FACTORS THAT CONTRIBUTE TO THE BUYING DECISION:

- Get members to try out the equipment, as "feel" is very important!
- How the stride feels. The average member will feel most comfortable between 18" and 22" in stride length. The taller the member, the longer the stride length.
- The adjustable incline feature allows members to determine which muscle groups get the most strenuous workout.
- The flywheel size on an elliptical is like motor size on a treadmill. The heavier the flywheel, the smoother and sturdier the elliptical.
- Programs are for motivation and direction; motivation helps push toward goals and direction helps to reach those goals.
- Heart rate programming provides an accurate way to determine how hard a user is working and how to get the most out of their workout.

CYCLES

THERE ARE THREE TYPES OF CYCLES:

- Recumbent Cycle
- Upright Cycle
- Spinning Cycle



It's important to understand the differences between a recumbent, upright and spinning cycle.

- Recumbent cycles have backs to the seats, making them easier on the back and knees and providing a more comfortable workout.
- An upright cycle more closely simulates the riding position of a road bike and normally costs less than a recumbent.
- The spinning cycles provide the closest experience to a real racing bicycle.
 With an aggressive seating position and pedals locked into the flywheel to prevent "coasting," these cycles provide the most challenging workouts.

STRENGTH

Types of strength training equipment include: home gyms, weight benches, free weights, dumbbells, toning bands, core training and select fitness accessories. If a member is looking to lose weight, tone or gain muscle, strength training can be very effective.



ACCESSORIES

Accessories are a vital part of providing a member the total solution.

All equipment will run better, last longer and provide a better member experience on a mat. Make sure to discuss this key accessory with every member.

Understanding your members' fitness goals will point you to the accessories they would benefit most from.
